

BIPOC Doula Scholarship Fund

The Little Timmy Project created the BIPOC Doula Scholarship Fund to provide aspiring and current birth workers access to funding as they seek further training that will help reduce these alarming disparities in the BIPOC community.

Scholarships must be used for a doula program approved by TLTP. The three programs applicants will be able to choose from are Doula Trainings International (DTI), SMC Full Circle Doula Training (Shafia Monroe) or Birthing Advocacy Doula Trainings (BADT).

A committee will review applicants.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Aspiring doulas who identify as Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC)
- Applicant must live in Indiana

HOW TO APPLY?

- Fill out application on our website.
- Applications due August 31st, 2021
- Scholarships will be awarded by December 31st, 2021
- Scholarship must be used within six months of awardment

HOW CAN THE FUNDS BE USED?

- Funding will be paid directly to the doula agency that the applicant has chosen to train with.

FUNDS DISTRIBUTED

- Up to \$1,000 will be distributed for each applicant's training

DONATE TO FUND

- Specific fundraisers/sponsorships will be used to fund this scholarship
